

I am pleased to announce that next year's 23rd Annual Scientific Meeting of the Singapore Radiological Society (SRS) and the College of Radiologists, Singapore (CRS) will incorporate the 11th Asia Pacific Congress of Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiology (APCCVIR). APCCVIR is the premier event on the interventional radiology calendar for the Asia Pacific region and we are very excited to be hosting it in 2014.

Our ASM will be held in Singapore, from 15th to 18th May 2014 at the Academia, Singapore General Hospital Campus with the theme 'InspIRation'.

APCCVIR 2014 aims to bring together doctors, nurses, radiographers, related paramedical staff and industry in all fields of Radiology and Interventional Radiology. The scientific programme aims to inspire all participants by exposing them to new perspectives in clinical developments in these exciting fields. It will not only focus on the emerging issues in Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiology, but also contain specialized tracks in Diagnostic Radiology, Radiation Oncology and Nuclear Medicine.

Members who do not want to participate in the full 4 days of the conference can register for only the 17th & 18th May when the Diagnostic Radiology, Radiation Oncology and paramedical tracks are held. We will also feature a mini-AIRP course on 16th and 17th May, featuring Cardiothoracic and Hepatobiliary topics. This was very popular and well subscribed when first organized at this year's ASM.

There will also be an exciting social programme held at attractive venues to inspire networking and fellowship among congress participants. The Congress banquet will be held at the Flower Dome, Gardens by the Bay, and will include entry to the Flower Dome. 



Case Study Diagnosis

Imaging findings: Contrast enhanced CT of the abdomen shows an infiltrative, large solid mass in the right suprarenal region. It directly invades the liver and the intra-hepatic portion of the inferior vena cava.

Diagnosis: Adrenocortical carcinoma (ACC) - functioning type

Discussion: ACCs are typically larger than pheochromocytomas and show early invasion of the renal vein or IVC. Less than 50% of ACCs are functioning. Among the functioning ones, Cushing's syndrome, Conn's syndrome and virilization are more common.
